
#### **Juniors Committee**



#### **HRM Junior High Outreach Representative**

- In schools for 75+ hours with hands-on time with students
- Over 60 classes taught
- 1250+ kids introduced to ultimate
- Future interest in a 1-day introductory tournament event for the junior high level in a format such as 4v4

The Juniors Committee budgeted to provide stipends to 2 representatives, however, lack of applicants resulted in only 1 position being offered.

#### **Disc Golf**

- King Hants Disc Golf Association and Mineville Disc Golf Club have formed and joined DiscNS as member clubs. South Shore is in the beginning stages.
- We continued to support grassroots growth: Provincial level team, course development, school and community programming, as well as events promoting the growth for Women and participation for individuals of all abilities:
  - Hyzers @HP/Ladies League
  - Course Expansion in Mineville
  - Accessibility and Course Infrastructure in New Minas
  - Play In My Shoes (Dartmouth and Dieppe), DiscoverAbilities
  - Learn to Play: HRCE PE Teachers, Scout Groups
  - Equipment: 9 Portable Baskets, Discs

#### **Disc Golf Future Goals**

- Continue to support clubs and organizations in sport development throughout the province
- Continue to advocate for new courses in underserved regions
- Seek ways to support recreation and amateur competition throughout the province.
- Foster growth within the sport for underrepresented populations (i.e. juniors, females, individuals with disabilities, first nations, newcomers)

#### **Treaty Responsibilities**

- To fulfill our treaty obligations, we tried to find ways of connecting with Indigenous Communities in Mi'kma'ki.
  - Obtained funding from Participaction in May 2024
  - Attended Building Bridges with Indigenous Athletes Seminar & connected with with Mi'kmaq Kina'matnewey (MK); discs for kids
  - Delivered 4 multisport clinics in community with MK (as of May 31st)
  - Attended Glooscap Traditional Powwow
  - Demo'ed ultimate at Nova Scotia Mi'kmaw Sport Summit 2024
  - Shot Challenge videos to teach ultimate skills

## F2025 DiscNS Treasurer Report

- A successful year for DiscNS with significant investment in our major priority areas.
- We are grateful for funding grants which make up almost 60% of our overall revenue along with significant revenue from our dues-paying members.
- While we had budgeted a surplus of just over \$2,900, we ended with a surplus of just over \$1400. The Board spent above budget amounts to support U19/Juniors and Disc Golf with spending on discs and disc equipment poised to make a difference in future years. This overspend with funded by underspend in Coaching and Observer budgets, which the board hopes to support in F26.
- The Board also supported various competitive teams with interim funding on their PAUC bids as well as providing financial support at all levels to ensure our sport remains affordable.
- As this is my last year as treasurer, I want to thank Amber Jelfs and this very dedicated group of board members. I am constantly impressed by their dedication to our sport and willingness to invest time in not only governance, but rolling up their sleeves and working with youth and community, including teams at all levels, to grow our sport.
